Hillingdon Choral Society

1. The choir aims to advance, improve, maintain education and appreciation of all aspects of music, through regular rehearsals and public concerts
2. There are no auditions but some ability to read music is an advantage.
3. Choir income is used to cover rehearsal costs (venue hire, conductor, accompanist, music hire etc) and any costs associated with concerts.
4. Membership is by annual/termly subscription and can be gift-aided. Members are encouraged to attend rehearsals on a regular basis and take part in all concerts.
5. We encourage all choir members to sell at least two tickets for each concert. Donations are very welcome.
6. Concerts are usually held at the end of each term (3 per year).
7. Contact with choir members will usually be by email. Members without emails will be contacted by mail or phone as appropriate.
8. The committee holds a list of names, addresses, telephone and email for each member. This is used solely for HCS business (pastoral care, rehearsal, concert or music information). Information will not be shared with other choir members without specific permission.
9. Committee members are elected annually at the AGM. All choir members are eligible to stand for committee. Choir members can be co-opted onto committee as appropriate to needs.
10. The committee is responsible for the contracts of Conductor and Accompanist.
11. Should the Choir activities cease; the Committee will decide on the organisations to which any remaining funds should be transferred.
